# **Scholarships**

There are two ways to participate in the Upper-Division Honors Program.

**1--Honors Transfer Scholarship** (Highest or second highest GPA in graduating class from an accredited community college)

Qualifications:

- Graduated first in class (4.0 GPA) or second in class (3.95 GPA or higher) from an accredited community college
- Must commit to full-time status at Coppin State (15 credits or more)

Provision:

• In-state Tuition and Fees

## 2--Honors Upper-Division Scholarship (For Coppin State students.)

Qualifications:

- 3.5 cumulative grade point average
- Completion of English Composition I and II or their equivalents
- Completion of no fewer than 45 credit hours and no more than 60 credit hours
- Full-time student

Provision:

• \$1500 each semester

# About the Upper-Division Honors Program

Participation in the Upper-Division Honors Program is extended to the transfer student or the Coppin State University student, preferably at the start of his/her junior year, who has demonstrated exceptional ability and has indicated an interest in graduate study. As a part of the Honors Program, the upper-division student will be led through the academic, cultural development, and leadership enrichment components of the Honors experience; however, the primary focus of the Program will be graduate-school preparation.

During the junior year, the Upper-Division student is required to complete any remaining honors-level general education courses required by the university in addition to one research course. Each summer, students are expected to apply for research assistantships or internships. Additional Honors Program requirements will include but are not limited to general program meetings, scholarly lectures, community service, graduate school and standardized test preparation workshops, and attendance at graduate school fairs.

Upper-Division Honors Program Scholarships are renewed each semester the student earns a current <u>and</u> cumulative grade point average of 3.2. Each scholarship recipient must also register and complete at least 15 credits each semester.
